

WELCOME THE RT HON THE EARL CADOGAN KBE DL

It gives me great pleasure to welcome you to London Playing Fields Foundation's Gala Dinner. Once again, The Savoy provides a wonderful setting for us to share our passion and commitment in creating a happier, healthier, more cohesive London by encouraging more people to play sport and be physically active.

I always feel a great sense of anticipation when the Gala Dinner draws near. This is partly because it is always such a wonderful evening spent with friends in such an iconic setting. But I am also excited by the prospect of being able to convey our key message that playing fields are much more than expanses of open space and are places where lives can be transformed and enriched.

At a time when society is increasingly concerned about rising obesity and the raft of preventable illnesses that come with it and the horrific number of young people who are dying every week as a result of knife crime, is it not illogical that we are losing those places where people can be more physically active on a regular basis and where teenagers can join teams rather than gangs? If we want our playing fields to remain the green hearts of local communities where our children and their children's children have somewhere safe to play the sport they love, we must evoke the same

vision, passion and altruism of our Victorian founders and do something about it.

I am delighted this evening to welcome back an old friend of the Foundation in Sir Tim Rice. We all know him for his magical lyrics, but Sir Tim is absolutely passionate about sport and its power as a force for good in society. Back in the 1990's he was a pivotal figure in the Peter May Memorial Appeal Committee whose contribution to the charity was transformational. I am sure that, like all his audiences across the globe, you'll be captivated by what he has to say.

Unsurprisingly this evening's pledge has a cricket theme. The drastic 41% decline in the number of natural turf pitches in London since 1990 has had a dramatic impact on participation rates because as we well know without a pitch to play on, there can be no cricket. Very few state schools have their own grass cricket pitches and it is not surprising therefore that only 22% of schools currently play competitive cricket. This year's pledge will seek to remedy this situation by rejuvenating state schools' cricket through a series of festivals and tournaments on LPFF facilities. What we can offer is access to good quality grass pitches and the expertise to organise tournaments and festivals that will stimulate initial interest in the game. If their first experience of

playing cricket is a positive one, boys and girls will be motivated and have the confidence to join a local club to continue on their sporting journey.

We believe that playing fields are where sport starts and for the gifted few such as Maggie Alphonsi Saracens and England legend and World Cup winner, they are where careers start. After attending her first training session at Saracens her life in rugby took off and she enjoyed a stellar career for club and country. Most recently she has been one of the main faces in ITV's coverage of the Rugby World Cup but in spite of her legendary status she has never forgotten her roots and is a great champion for sport and how it can help to transform and enrich lives.

Finally, this is my last Gala Dinner as Chairman of the Foundation. It has been a pleasure and a privilege to serve this fantastic charity in its mission to provide a place to play sport forever.



TONIGHT'S GUEST SPEAKER SIR TIM RICE



Sir Tim is an iconic English musical theatre lyricist of Broadway, West End and film, winner of three Oscars, three Tonys, three Golden Globes and several Grammys.

Sir Tim's much-loved work has given pleasure to millions around the world: Joseph and the Amazing Technicolour Dreamcoat; Jesus Christ Superstar and Evita (with Andrew Lloyd Webber); Memorial Appeal which raised Chess (with Bjorn Ulvaeus and Benny Andersson of ABBA); Aladdin and Beauty and the Beast (with Alan Menken) and The Lion King (with Elton John) - to name a few. In 1994 Tim was knighted by HM The Queen for services to music and in 2008 his star joined the Hollywood Walk of Fame.

Sir Tim is a Sunderland AFC fan and an avid supporter of cricket. In 1973 he established Heartaches Cricket Club, the name inspired by an Elvis Presley song. He was President of Lord's Taverners in 2000 and Marylebone Cricket Club in 2002-03 and is currently President of the London Library.

In 1995 Sir Tim joined the Peter May £1.4million to build the Peter May Sports Centre in Waltham Forest in 2000. Over the last nineteen years the centre has provided high quality practice and playing opportunities for thousands of cricketers including the majority of the current double winning Essex CCC squad.

MADE IN LONDON **AWARD**



Playing fields are where sport starts and for the gifted few they are where careers start. The vast majority of past and present elite sportsmen and women will look back with a debt of gratitude and real affection to that local field in their youth where they honed their skills and fuelled their love for their chosen sport.

We celebrate the contribution that playing fields make to the lives of our sporting heroes by creating a special London Playing Fields Foundation Made in London Award. We are delighted to announce this year's winner is former England and Saracens player Maggie Alphonsi.

Maggie is the face of international women's rugby and arguably one of the most well-known names in women's team sports on the planet. Before announcing her international retirement in 2014, she represented her country an impressive 74 times. scored 28 tries, won a World Cup and helped England win a record breaking seven consecutive Six Nations crowns.

Born in Lewisham, Maggie had initially taken the game up at school, after encouragement from her PE teacher, who just happened to be Liza Burgess,

captain of the Welsh women's rugby team and all round star of the game herself. By a quirk of fate Liza also happened to be the Foundation's Champion Coaching Head Rugby Union coach back in the 1990's.

After attending a training session at Saracens, Maggie never looked back. She had natural attributes for rugby, not least total fearlessness, and unsurprisingly progressed quickly. At the age of 18, she was selected for the England Academy squad, winning her first cap a year later which proved the springboard for the hugely successful career in the sport that followed.

WHAT WE DO AND THE DIFFERENCE YOUR **SUPPORT WILL MAKE**

Our vision is to create a happier, healthier, more cohesive London by encouraging more people to play sport on affordable, accessible and attractive playing fields. Playing fields are more than just green space and are places where lives can be improved physically, mentally and socially.

We receive no direct financial support from central or local government and so are therefore dependent on the generosity of individuals like yourselves to deliver on our mission of providing a place to play sport forever.

Your support tonight will go towards:

OUR PLAYING FIELDS

We own and manage seven grounds across five London boroughs which are used by over 200,000 people every year to stay fit and healthy.

In order to widen, increase and sustain participation we provide high quality playing pitches for schools, colleges, universities, clubs and community groups at affordable hiring costs.

However, operating these playing fields is expensive – for every £1 we invest in maintenance and management of a sports pitch we only recoup 39p in hiring income. In order to continue subsidising our playing fields so that they are accessible to all we rely on a combination of grant aid, commercial partnerships and the generosity of our supporters. In the current climate where local authorities are under pressure to build new homes and cut council expenditure, playing fields have never been under greater threat.

We believe that it is vitally important that we continue to demonstrate how well managed and maintained playing fields can help provide those teams and individuals who use them with a real sense of belonging.





OUR PROJECTS

For some people staying fit and healthy is hard, physically and economically. We are committed to providing opportunities for some of London's most disadvantaged groups to reap the benefits of playing sport which can extend well beyond the pitch. Sport can do so much to bring communities together, raise aspirations and provide an alternative to crime and anti-social behaviour. The Fields of Dreams Report, a 12-month piece of research published a couple of years ago, found that the minimum savings to the public purse of just one of our grounds was £4.8million. Having reached and engaged with these groups, we work with a range of partners such as the NHS, governing bodies of sport and community organisations to provide life changing experiences.

Examples of these projects include:

- · Coping Through Footballa transformational project that demonstrates how sporting charities can work with the NHS to engage with and improve the wellbeing of adults and young people experiencing mental health issues.
- Saturday Morning Soccerfun and supportive sessions for primary school aged girls and boys who currently do not play in teams
- Green Hearts– making playing fields more relevant to the local community by encouraging greater use for informal walking and jogging

OUR PLAYING FIELDS PROTECTION

Once a playing field is lost, it is lost forever so our mantra is no net loss of pitches. We believe that playing fields are vital to local communities and are determined to continue our role in opposing the current and future loss of playing fields in London. We are the first port of call for advice on protecting threatened playing fields and have produced a Playing Fields Charter for London which calls on the GLA, sporting bodies and local authorities to have a long term view of the contribution playing fields make to creating happier, healthier, more cohesive communities. We also maintain the Fields at Risk Register which is an early warning system that lists sites in imminent danger of commercial or residential development and has resulted in over 20 threatened sites being saved for current and future generations of Londoners.

Did you know that over the last 20 years London has lost 41% of its natural turf wickets? Given the link between participation and access to accessible and affordable pitches, it is therefore not surprising that only 22% of state schools play competitive cricket.

The purpose of this year's pledge is to use our facilities to rejuvenate state schools' cricket through a series of festivals and tournaments on LPFF facilities. We aim to raise £20,000 to deliver playing opportunities for over 2,700 school children, stimulating the playing and practising of cricket in 122 schools across London.

Organisations like Chance to Shine do a brilliant job in taking cricket into schools and the recently founded London Cricket Trust is making great strides in increasing the number of artificial turf pitches especially in inner city areas.

What London Playing Fields Foundation can offer is access to good quality grass pitches and the expertise to organise tournaments and festivals that will stimulate initial interest in the game. If their first experience of playing cricket is a positive one, boys and girls will have motivation and confidence to join a local club where they can continue their sporting journey.

Most club grounds just have one cricket square so their ability to run multi-team tournaments and festivals is limited. However, the Foundation is blessed with several pitches on a number of its grounds and therefore is perfectly placed to work in partnership on joint initiatives that increase and sustain participation.

The Foundation will work with schools, local clubs, county cricket boards and Chance to Shine to ignite and develop a love of the game.

£20,000 raised on the night will pay for:

- Eight kwik cricket festivals for 96 schools
- Three Under 13 hard ball leagues for 18 schools
- One festival for Under 13 girls for six schools
- Six kwik cricket bags for each venue
- One schools team kit bag for every game at each venue
