WELCOME FROM ALEX WELSH CHIEF EXECUTIVE LONDON PLAYING FIELDS FOUNDATION

Good evening and welcome to the LPFF Quiz here at one of sport's most iconic arenas, The Kia Oval. Thank you so much for coming and supporting us in our mission to provide a place to play sport forever.

I always feel a tingle of awe and excitement when I come to this wonderful sporting arena with its unrivalled history. It is a stadium of firsts. Home to the first ever FA Cup Final, the first international football match, the first home Test match and the first varsity rugby match. It does not escape my attention either that the key protagonists of The FA and MCC at the time of these inaugural matches were the same visionary Victorians who founded London Playing Fields Foundation in 1890. They recognised that the nation could not produce top international players without a wide participation base at grass roots. So this historic stadium reflects that golden thread that runs from the amateur through to the professional game. At LPFF we believe that playing fields are where sport starts and for the gifted few, they are where careers start. There will be many top sportsmen and women who look back with genuine gratitude and affection to a local field where, during their childhood, they honed their skills and developed their love of sport.

Our founders also knew that sport could transform and improve lives, but only if we had sufficient pitches on which to play it. That is why I am excited by the prospect of being able to convey our key message that playing fields are much more than expanses of open space and are places where lives can be transformed and enriched. At a time when society is increasingly concerned about rising obesity and the raft of preventable illnesses that come with it and the horrific number of young people who are dying every week as a result of knife crime, is it not illogical that we are losing those places where people can be more physically active on a regular basis and where teenagers can join teams rather than gangs?

Even back in the 1890's they knew that the benefits of sport extended well beyond the pitch and could have a lasting impact on health and social issues. Had they had a crystal ball I am sure that they would have been absolutely delighted to witness 129 years later the same charity they had set up staging a fundraising event and celebrating its ground-breaking work at this grand old stadium which had formed the backdrop to the birth of our two national sports.

That London is one of the greenest and most sporting cities in the world is not an accident. It was due to the efforts of people like you who supported London Playing Fields Foundation across the decades in its fight to arrest the often insidious loss of playing fields so that sport could be more accessible to Londoners. Today with the huge demand for more new homes, the pressure on our green spaces has never been greater and if we want future generations to have the



same rich sporting experience as we enjoyed we need to remain ever vigilant because once a playing field is lost, it is lost forever.

Providing playing fields for the community and in particular disadvantaged groups costs money with our hiring income only covering 39% of the running costs; and as we receive no direct funding from central or local government we need your help to ensure that your children and their children's children have somewhere to play and have their lives enriched through sport. So, thanks again for your support, it is greatly appreciated.

I would also like to thank the LPFF Quiz Organising Committee who have worked tirelessly over the past six months to ensure that you enjoy your evening. Judging by previous events, I am sure you will enjoy what will no doubt be a highly competitive and thoroughly entertaining quiz in the company of your friends. And just as importantly, if you are not already a champion for the protection, provision and promotion of playing fields, hopefully by the end of this evening you will be. May the best team win!

WHAT WE DO

Our vision is to create a happier, healthier, more cohesive London by encouraging more people to play sport and be physically active on affordable and accessible playing fields. We believe that playing fields are more than just expanses of open space, they are places where lives can be improved.

OUR PLAYING FIELDS

We own and manage seven grounds across five London boroughs which are used by over 200,000 people every year to stay fit and healthy. We offer the best quality playing surfaces for grassroots clubs and work hard to ensure that everyone who wants to play sport on our grounds such as schools, clubs and community groups can do so through affordable hiring costs.

Operating these playing fields is expensive – for every £1 we invest in maintaining them we only recoup 39p in hiring income. We rely on the generosity of our supporters as well as commercial partnerships at our grounds in order to continue subsidising our playing fields to allow everyone to access them.

OUR CONTRIBUTION TO PROTECTING PLAYING FIELDS

Once a playing field is lost, it is lost forever. We believe in the value of playing fields and are determined to prevent the future loss of sports grounds and green spaces in London. We act as the first port of call for advice on protecting threatened playing fields and administer a Fields at Risk Register which is an early warning system against potential loss from commercial or residential development. We also want to promote greater recognition of the value of recreational green spaces and have produced a Charter for Playing Fields in London, a 12 point call to action for all those Councils and sporting organisations that have responsibility for their provision.
