	Screening of staff before they arrive at the venue to ensure individuals displaying COVID-19 symptoms or those who should be shielding do not travel or attend.	Explicit verbal or written confirmation from each staff member that they are not required by NHS Test and Trace to self-isolate and are not required by Government Guidance to self-isolate because they, or someone in their household, have had symptoms of COVID-19 within the prescribed timeframe	
	Staff allocation	One member of staff to supervise use of toilet.	
	Assess user numbers, space capacities, venue circulation and layout planning to maintain social distancing.	External capacity: to meet NGB guidelines Internal capacity: "1 in 1" out system for use of toilet.	
	Signage to make all users aware of the control measures in place and how to act appropriately to minimise the risk of transmission of COVID-19.	Signage: Site specific signs manufactured and installed

	Provision of hand washing facilities with warm water, soap, disposable towels and bin.	Facilities to be available in toilet area. Check regularly and re-stock as necessary Remove rubbish as necessary.	
	Provision of suitable hand sanitiser in locations around the facility to maintain frequent hand sanitisation.	Sanitiser at entrance to and exit from building	
	Cleaning strategy to minimise risk of COVID-19 transmission.	All surfaces in areas to be used to be cleaned before and after each session.	
	High-frequency touchpoint cleaning strategy to minimise COVID-19 transmission risk.	High-frequency touch points to be cleaned at regular intervals during each session: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Entrance door handle • Toilet door handle • Toilet flush • Basin taps • Soap and sanitizer dispensers 	
	Ensure cleaning materials and PPE is on site to allow for effective protection and cleaning.	Materials to be kept at pre-determined stock levels. Order turnaround time of 48 hours

	Assess the maximum occupancy of external and internal areas in use to maintain current social distancing guidance. Establish a suitable circulation system/one-way system if necessary and use signage/floor markings to communicate this as necessary. 	Non-personal equipment belonging to LPFF to be cleaned before and after each session.	Goalposts on artificial pitch, if used during session, to be cleaned.	
	Condition of playing surfaces	Artificial and grass pitches to be prepared and maintained by LPFF to usual standard
