Hygiene and Cleaning			
	Provision of hand washing facilities with warm water, soap, disposable towels and bin.	GLL	
	Provision of suitable hand sanitiser in locations around the facility to maintain frequent hand sanitisation.	GLL	
	Cleaning strategy to minimise risk of COVID-19 transmission.	GLL	
	High-frequency touchpoint cleaning strategy to minimise COVID-19 transmission risk.	GLL	
	Ensure cleaning materials and PPE is on site to allow for effective protection and cleaning.	GLL
