# WELCOME THE HON WILLIAM CADOGAN

It gives me great pleasure to welcome you to the London Playing Fields Foundation's Gala Dinner for what promises to be another wonderful evening.

Once again, The Savoy provides a wonderful setting for us to share our passion and commitment in creating a happier, healthier, more cohesive London by encouraging more people to play sport and be physically active. For those attending for the first time London Playing Fields Foundation is the leading body for the protection, provision and promotion of playing fields in the capital. It is through our work in operating seven large playing fields and our campaigning to save others that might be under threat that we strive to achieve our dual mission of providing a place to play sport forever and creating more active communities. Without a pitch to play on there can be no sports such as football, rugby and cricket and how can we encourage local people to be more active if they do not have access to safe spaces where they can exercise informally?

However, despite utilisation rates of our grounds being impressively high, we rely heavily on events like this evening to raise much needed funds. For every pound that we invest in the management and maintenance of our pitches we only recoup 33p from hiring income and this is because we are committed to addressing inequalities by providing facilities that are accessible, affordable and attractive.

Last year we had thought that the impact of the pandemic, which forced the closure of our grounds for a total of 35 weeks over two protracted lockdowns, would be the worst thing that could happen to the Foundation. However, the rapidly escalating cost of living crisis compounded by our energy costs rising by over 400%, constitute the biggest threat to our 132 year existence. That is why we are so grateful for your support.

We often say that the benefits of sport extend well beyond the pitch, and there is no better example of this than the subject of tonight's pledge our mental health project Coping Through Football which has improved and sometimes saved the lives of some of our most vulnerable individuals and frequently those at most risk. Working in collaboration with the NHS, we have achieved this by supporting participants to actively adopt more positive coping strategies and to make improved lifestyle choices and by working with agencies to establish suicide prevention initiatives.

Given that roughly a third of adult attendees since 2007 have a diagnosis of Schizophrenia, with the project assisting in the recovery of individuals discharged from acute services to stay well living in the community, there is no doubt that the project has resulted in huge savings on acute mental health services.

Finally, playing fields are where sport begins and for the gifted few they are where careers begin and I am sure that the esteemed recipient of this year's Made In London Award Roy Hodgson CBE would endorse that sentiment. Born and bred in Croydon, Roy has enjoyed a stellar career in football coaching and in a remarkable 44 years has managed some of the world's leading clubs and three national teams, including England of course from 2012-2016. As one of the game's most respected and erudite figures, we are deeply honoured that he is with us tonight to receive the Made in London Award

Playing fields are where sport starts and for the gifted few they are where careers start. The vast majority of past and present elite sportsmen and women will look back with a debt of gratitude and real affection to that local field in their youth where they honed their skills and fuelled their love for their chosen sport. We celebrate the contribution that playing fields make to the lives of our sporting heroes by creating a special London Playing Fields Foundation Made in London Award. We are delighted to announce this year's winner is former England Football Manager Roy Hodgson CBE.

Roy was born and raised in Croydon and has never forgotten his south London roots.

During his long and distinguished career, Roy has managed 22 different teams in eight countries, beginning in Sweden with Halmstads BK in 1976. He later guided the unfashionable Switzerland national team to the last 16 of the 1994 World Cup and qualification for Euro 1996.

#### MADE IN LONDON AWARD

After a spell with Finland, he then successfully managed numerous leading clubs at home and abroad including Inter Milan, Blackburn Rovers, Malmö FF, Grasshoppers, FC Copenhagen, Udinese, Fulham, Liverpool and West Bromwich Albion, before being offered the ultimate accolade of managing the English national team on a four year contract in 2012. Following his time with England, Roy joined his boyhood club Crystal Palace for a further four years before enjoying a final hurrah with Watford in May 2022.

A great servant to the game, Roy has been a frequent member of UEFA and FIFA technical study groups reporting on various European Championships and World Cup tournaments. An accomplished communicator and fluent in five languages, he has been a very popular television pundit in several of the countries in which he has coached. We are delighted that Roy is with us tonight to accept the Made in London Award.

## WHAT WE DO AND **THE DIFFERENCE YOUR** SUPPORT WILL MAKE

Our vision is to create a happier, healthier, more cohesive London by encouraging more people to play sport on affordable, accessible and attractive playing fields. Playing fields are more than just green space and are places where lives can be improved physically, mentally and socially.

Unlike Local Authorities that can subsidise their playing fields through their council tax, we rely on the generosity of individuals like yourselves to deliver on our mission of providing a place to play sport forever.

Your support tonight will go towards:

#### **OUR PLAYING FIELDS**

We own and manage seven grounds across five London boroughs which are used by over 200,000 people every year to stay fit and healthy.

In order to widen, increase and sustain participation we provide high quality playing pitches for schools, colleges, universities, clubs and community groups at affordable hiring costs.

However, operating these playing fields is expensive – for every £1 we invest in maintenance and management of a sports pitch we only recoup 33p in hiring income. In order to continue subsidising our playing fields so that they are accessible to all we rely on a combination of grant aid, commercial partnerships and the generosity of our supporters. In the current climate where local authorities are under pressure to build new homes and cut council expenditure, playing fields have never been under greater threat.

We believe that it is vitally important that we continue to demonstrate how well managed and maintained playing fields can help provide those teams and individuals who use them with a real sense of belonging.



#### **OUR PROJECTS**

For some people staying fit and healthy is hard, physically and economically. We are committed to providing opportunities for some of London's most disadvantaged groups to reap the benefits of playing sport which can extend well beyond the pitch. Sport can do so much to bring communities together, raise aspirations and provide an alternative to crime and anti-social behaviour.

The Fields of Dreams Report, a 12-month piece of research published a couple of years ago, found that the minimum savings to the public purse of just one of our grounds was £4.8million. Having reached and engaged with these groups, we work with a range of partners such as the NHS, governing bodies of sport and community organisations to provide life changing experiences.

Examples of these projects include:

 Coping Through Football– a transformational project that demonstrates how sporting charities can work with the NHS to engage with and improve the wellbeing of adults and young people experiencing mental health issues.

- Saturday Morning Soccer–
- Green Hearts– making playing fields more informal walking and jogging.

#### **OUR PITCH PROTECTION**

Once a playing field is lost, it is lost forever so when it comes to protection our mantra is no net loss of pitches and if they are lost to development they should be replaced. The LPFF is the first port of call when people are concerned about the loss of a playing field.

We know that the public health and social value of playing fields to local communities is huge and that is why we are committed to opposing the current and future loss of playing fields in London.

Our Playing Fields Charter for London urges the Greater London Authority, local authorities and sporting bodies to adopt a long term view of the contribution that playing fields make to creating happier, healthier, more cohesive communities.

We also maintain a Fields at Risk Register, an early warning system that lists sites in imminent danger of commercial or residential development and which, over the last ten years, has resulted in saving over 20 threatened sites for current and future generations of Londoners.



Tonight, we are making a special request for vour support to help us transform, and in some cases even save, the lives of people whose lives have been blighted by poor mental health.

In the UK every day **16 people** will take their own lives and suicide is the commonest cause of death amongst 20-49-year-old males. Unable to stand by and allow young adults to contemplate ending it all, we at London Playing Fields Foundation, decided to approach North East London Foundation Trust seventeen years ago with a ground breaking project entitled **Coping Through Football**. With the goal of transforming community mental health services and delivered across four north east London boroughs via six sessions per week for 50 weeks of the year, the project has become a beacon of best practice.

#### Since then:

- The project has been recognised as an example of outstanding practice by UEFA who awarded it a Grassroots Award.
- Following a two-year study conducted by University College London between 2016-2018, Coping Through Football is the most evaluated football and mental health project anywhere in the

world. We now have evidence that proves the physical, health, social and lifestyle benefits of the project to back up participants' testimony of the difference it has made to their lives.

 As well as saving lives, the project also makes financial sense. It costs £425 per day to keep a person in an inpatient ward. CTF costs £34 per participant per day and the research found that there was a 12% reduction in 'bed-day' usage by CTF participants. When you consider that the annual cost of looking after someone with schizophrenia is £72,000 per year and over a third of the people referred to us have the condition, it becomes clear how much the project is saving the public purse.

#### **A SERVICE WITH A DIFFERENCE THAT NEVER** LETS ITS CLIENTS DOWN

Working in collaboration with our partners NELFT (North East London Foundation Trust) and

Leyton Orient Trust, we use the football environment firstly as a tool for engaging with people with significant needs who typically do not access existing mental health services and then as a therapeutic intervention that helps to restore confidence, build resilience and get their lives back on track. We support adults and young people to actively adopt more positive coping strategies and to make improved lifestyle choices and we work with agencies to establish suicide prevention initiatives.

However, every three years we have a funding challenge and as we reach Phase 6 2023-2026 we are faced with a funding gap of £30,000 for the next year. If you, like us at LPFF cannot stand idly by while young people and adults endure so much suffering, please look at the table opposite and see what you can do to really make a difference and help us to complete this stage of our mission. As you can see everything helps and we would like to thank you in advance for all that you can pledge.

It's helping me a lot with my depression now... I engage with more people... When here, when doing this, I don't feel alone, I don't feel like I am a bad person, like I am the worst person in the world. Here I don't think anyone really judges me for that.
