USEFUL INFORMATION

Play

All visiting players must possess current club handicaps (maximum 24 for Gentlemen and 36 for Ladies). The maximum time expected to play 18 holes is 4 hours 30 minutes. The Course Marshals are authorised by the Management to notify players if they lose ground with those ahead.

Lockers and facilities

There are changing facilities, details of which will be given on the day. There are lockers available and towels are provided. Please see the Locker Room attendant to obtain a key.

Dress code

Courses and Practice Facilities

- Recognised smart golfing attire (No blue denim, t-shirts, tracksuits, football or rugby shirts).
- Men's shirts must be tucked in at all times.
- Tailored shorts, worn with ankle or long socks.
- Golf shoes must be worn.

Clubhouse and Terrace

- All hats, caps and visors must be removed when entering the clubhouse.
- Men's shirts must be tucked in at all times.
- Recognised golfing or smart casual attire (no blue denim).
- Tailored shorts.
- Golf, leisure and sandal style footwear (no flip-flops or sliders).
- Jackets, collared shirts and ties may be required for specific occasions, subject to prior notification.

Mobile Phones, Message Devices and Laptops

- All devices should be on silent in all areas of the courses, clubhouse and terrace.
- Mobiles may be used for data transmission only within the Clubhouse and on the courses.
- Mobiles may be answered and used discreetly within the locker rooms, car park, terrace areas, practice facilities and when hiring a private meeting room.
- Laptops and other computers may be operated within the Clubhouse and on the terrace.
- Woburn is an advocate of 'Ready Golf' and you are encouraged to maintain an acceptable Pace of Play at all times. Please be prepared and ready to play your shots and be aware of golfers both in front and behind you
